

Spring Book Report

1. Choose a chapter book from a variety of fiction genres including, mystery, realistic fiction, science fiction, historical fiction. *The book cannot be a graphic novel and must be 50+ pages. **You will have the entire month of April to read this book.***
2. Visit our classroom website and locate the Spring Book Report Page. Add your book to the sign up sheet. **Due: Thursday, March 30th.**
3. You will receive a blue folder before April Vacation to help you stay organized at home. *This folder includes some materials you will need throughout the project. Purchase a 22" x 28" poster board, any color is fine. **Final Book Report Due: Friday, May 11th.***

Components on your Posters

1. Title, Author, and your name visibly centered on your *22" x 28" poster board*.
2. **Design a Book Cover:** Design a new cover for the book you chose. Use the white blank drawing paper supplied in your folder to design this cover. You must include the Title and the Author.
3. **Amazon Review:** In your own words, complete all the parts included on the Amazon Review. Make sure you complete a rough draft *found in your packet* prior to completing the final product on the hard, card stock paper.
4. **Timeline/ Storyline:** Use the timeline provided in your folder to represent the storyline of your book in 10 slides. You may use illustrations and/or words.
5. **Vocabulary Collection:** While you enjoy your book, be on the lookout for interesting words. Include 5 of these words on the Vocabulary Collection Chart. Make sure you complete a rough draft prior to completing the final product on the hard, card stock paper.

Extra Credit: Add 3 symbols around the poster that represent the story.
Add 3-5 drawings and labels of the main characters.

Expectations for the Assignment/ Rubric:

Each component of your poster board is worth 20 points. Follow the directions for each, be creative, and make sure your visual presentation is neat and appealing to the audience.
